ABSTRACT PAINTING TO MUSIC

COURSE DURATION: 6 weeks (2 hours per week).

WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?

This course is available to adults aged 19+ who want an opportunity to discover the link between music and art. The emphasis will be on fun and pure enjoyment of art and painting coupled with the enjoyment and expressive nature of music. No previous knowledge of the subject is required.

WHAT WILL I LEARN?

By the end of this course you will be able to:

- Express yourself creatively by using colour with paint and brushwork (expressive marking)
- Recognise the basic link between music and art
- Create expressive abstract and conceptual art pieces

HOW WILL I LEARN?

- Through tutor demonstrations
- Discussions
- Practical tasks
- Whole group and individual work with support from tutor
